GWAC is pleased to display the artwork of D.L. Kaulbach at Huggins Hospital this July and August (painting pictured above). A native of Brooklyn, New York, D.L. Kaulbach started painting in high school, but was sidetracked by a career in nursing, marriage, and raising four children. After moving to Marblehead, MA, she resumed painting. In the Seventies, Kaulbach and her husband, Dr. Maximiliaan Kaulbach, bought a vacation home in Alton. An avid gardener, she tries to convey her love of nature and in particular the beauty of New England in her watercolors, oils, and pastels.

Having lived in Europe and traveling extensively is a source of inspiration for her painting. She is a longtime member of Marblehead Arts Association, Swampscott Arts Association, and in more recent years, a member of GWAC.

Makers Mill Searching for Maker Fellow

G.A.L.A. Makers Mill, located in Wolfeboro, NH, is searching for an enthusiastic and self-motivated person to add to its team who has knowledge of the makerspace community, or is an avid maker, and the ability to collaborate with staff to design and build new maker-centered learning programming, systems and partnerships.

The position is being made available through the Makers & Mentors Network AmeriCorps VISTA Program and is a one year term from August 2021 to July 2022. Benefits include a living stipend of \$13,362.70/year, a \$400/month housing stipend, a Segal Education Award of \$6,195 upon successful completion or end of year cash stipend of \$1,800, healthcare coverage, and child care subsidy.
